## Positive Behaviour and Consequences

Cubs will keep their Scout Promise, Law and will be guided by our Scout Values.

### Cub Scout Promise

### Cub Scout Law

Cubs always do their best,  
think of others before themselves  
and do a good turn every day.

### Scout Values:

**Integrity:** We act with integrity; we are honest, trustworthy and loyal.

**Respect:** We have self-respect and respect for others.

**Care:** We support others and take care of the world in which we live.

**Belief:** We explore our faiths, beliefs and attitudes.

**Cooperation:** We make a positive difference; we co-operate with others and make friends.

### Positive Behaviour

Jungle Book friends will be handed out to Cubs who have shown they are keeping their Cub Scout Promise, Law and following our Scout Values.

### Consequences

If Cubs are not keeping their Cub Scout Promise, Law or following Scout Values they will be given a warning.

- **Warning One** – Stop and think about your behaviour.
- **Warning Two** – Take a time out and think about your behaviour.
- **Warning Three** – Leaders will speak with Cub and parents.

**More than three warnings** – If you receive more than three warnings in one night or you continue to receive warnings each week, you will be asked to miss a cub meeting and we will speak about how you plan to improve your behaviour.

**Dangerous or threatening behaviour** – If a Cub instigates dangerous or threatening behaviour towards themselves or others, they will automatically receive three warnings, parents will be spoken with and they will be asked to miss a cub meeting. Any further incidents will be escalated to our Group Scout Leader.
